ACCESS TO PHENOTYPING

Only those with an active phenotyping experiment on the LemnaTec system will be allowed in the Bellwether Phenotyping Facility.

Scheduling request and other instructions:

In order to maintain social distancing requirements, a maximum of <u>**2 people</u>** will be allowed in the Bellwether Phenotyping Facility at any time.</u>

- If you are an active user, and have planned work in the Bellwether facility, you
 must coordinate this work with Phenotyping staff at least <u>48 hours</u> in advance.
- If you would like to reserve time on other phenotyping instruments, you must coordinate this work with Phenotyping staff at least <u>1 week</u> in advance.

PPE and other safety requirements:

For your safety and to minimize the risk of SARS-CoV2 transmission, please wear the following PPE while in the Phenotyping Facility at ALL times until further notice:

- clean gloves (provided)
- face mask
- disposable lab coat (provided)
